# Ke Kuhikuhi ‘ana o ka ‘IMA

## Ka hana a ke kumu:

1. ‘I (‘Ike): ‘Akahi, e nīele i nā haumāna i ka mea i maopopo iā lākou no ke ‘ano o ke ‘Aloha’. E kākau i kā lākou mau pane ma ka papa ke‘oke‘o a i ‘ole ma ka pepa ho‘olaha, ma lalo o ka māhele
2. M (Makemake e ‘Ike): ‘Alua, e nīele i nā haumāna i kā lākou mea e makemake ai e ‘ike no ke ‘Aloha’. E helu i kēia mau nīnau ma lalo o ka māhele ‘M’.
3. A (A‘o): ‘Akolu, e wehewehe i nā haumāna ‘o ka hana ma hope o ka ha‘awina, e nānā hou ‘oukou i kēia papa e nānā ai i ka mea i a‘o ‘ia no ke ‘Aloha’.

## HANA WAU

1. Ho‘omaka ma ka nīele ‘ana i nā haumāna inā maopopo iā lākou ke ‘ano o ke aloha.
2. E wehewehe ‘o ke ‘ano o ke Aloha, ua lehulehu nō, akā, ‘o ke ‘ano ma‘amau nō, ‘o ka hō‘ike‘ike ‘ana i ka ‘olu‘olu, ka lokomaika‘i, a me ka mahalo.
3. E ha‘i aku i nā haumāna ‘o ka ha‘awina o kēia lā, ‘o ke a‘o ‘ana no nā mea hou aku no ke Aloha a me ka hō‘ike‘ike ‘ana i ke Aloha i ko lākou mau hoaloha.



4. Heluhelu a kūkākūkā: E heluhelu i kekahi puke kamali'i no ke Aloha, eia kekahi::  
Kolohe Time Ka 'Aina Aloha 'ole" na Vaihi Entertainment, LLC. E wehewehe pōkole no ka mo'olelo o ka puke, mai wehewehe ā piha.

5. E ho'okū i ka heluhelu 'ana ma nā māhele mea nui no ke kūkākūkā pū no kekahi mau māhele o ka mo'olelo. Penei kekahi 'ano nīnau: He aha ke 'ano o ke Aloha?

- Pehea kākou e hō'ike'ike ai i ke Aloha i ko kākou mau hoaloha?
- No ke aha he mea nui ka hō'ike'ike 'ana i ke Aloha i nā po'e 'ē a'e?
- E paipai i nā haumāna e hō'ike'ike i ko lākou mau mana'o a me kā lākou mau hana no ke Aloha.

6. A pau pono ka heluhelu 'ia o ka puke, e ho'omaka i ke kūkā 'ana no ka po'e o loko o ka mo'olelo. E nīele no ka hana i hō'ike'ike ai ia po'e i ke 'ano o ke 'Aloha' ma loko o ka mo'olelo.



# HANA KAKOU

## Hana Nā Hopena A'O

- E wehewehe 'o ka hana Nā Hopena A'O, he kuhikuhi 'ana no ke kōkua 'ana i nā haumāna ma ke kūkulu 'ana i nā 'ike a me nā 'ano hana e ulu ai ke kanaka.
- E nānā i nā kuhikuhi 'ana no ke "Aloha" a e kūkākūkā no ka hō'ike'ike 'ana i ke Aloha ma nā 'ano like 'ole.
- E ho'oka'awale i nā haumāna ma nā pū'ulu li'ili'i a e hā'awi i kēlā kēia pū'ulu i wahi mo'olelo pōkole, penei kekahi 'ano:
  - Ua kaumaha kou hoaloha, no ka mea, 'a'ole i maika'i kona kaha ma kekahi hō'ike. Pehea 'oe e hō'ike ai i ke Aloha iā ia?
  - He mea hou kou hoaloha ma ke kula, 'a'ohe ona hoa pā'ani ma ka hola ho'omaha. Pehea 'oe e hō'ike ai i ke Aloha iā ia?
- E noi i kēlā kēia pū'ulu e no'ono'o i kekahi hana keaka pōkole e hō'ike'ike ai i kā lākou hana e hō'ike'ike ai i ke Aloha no nā mo'olelo ma luna a'e.



## HANA 'OE

1. E noi i nā haumāna e no'ono'o no kā lākou mau mea i a'o ai no ke 'Aloha' a me kā lākou mau hana e hō'ike'ike ai i ke Aloha i ko lākou mau hoaloha.
2. Hō'ike mai nā haumāna i ko lākou mau mana'o, pēlā e hiki ai i ke kumu ke loiloi i ko lākou 'apo 'ana i ka ha'awina.
3. E paipai i nā haumāna e ho'oma'ama'a i ka hō'ike'ike i ko lākou 'Aloha' i ko lākou mau hoaloha ma ke kula a ma ka home.

## PANI

1. Hō'ulu'ulu: E wehewehe pōkole i ka mea i a'o 'ia no ke 'Aloha' a me kona ho'oikaika 'ana i ka pilina ma waena o nā hoaloha.
2. A (A'o): E nānā hou i ka papa 'IMA a e ho'opihapiha i ka māhele 'A' me nā mea a nā haumāna i a'o ai. Closure: End the lesson with the Aloha song, reminding students to practice showing 'Aloha' to their friends and others.
3. Pani: E pani i ka ha'awina me ka hīmeni Aloha, e ho'omaopopo i nā haumāna e ho'oma'ama'a i ke 'Aloha' i ko lākou po'e hoaloha a me nā po'e a pau loa.





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
